Government Announcement – Next Steps

Following the Prime Minister's announcement this evening that we have an immediate lockdown nationally, I am writing to confirm arrangements for

- Emergency provision in school for children of critical workers and vulnerable students
- Free School Meals
- Work packs for those without internet access

Emergency provision on-site

We have a small provision operating from the school site for children of key workers and vulnerable students. Guidance is clear that students can only access this provision if there is no safe alternative at home. We are committed to protecting the most vulnerable and to supporting critical workers who are so essential to keeping our communities safe at this time. It is vitally important that parents/carers do not use this provision unless it is absolutely necessary.

Free School Meals

With effect from tomorrow, Free School Meals will no longer be available for collection due to the requirement not to leave your house other than for exercise once a day and essential food shopping. We will be issuing food vouchers to families in receipt of Free School Meals as soon as possible, details will follow tomorrow to those families affected.

Work packs

We are aware that for a number of students, accessing the work that is being set every day is difficult either due to lack of internet access and/or lack of devices at home.

From tomorrow, it will not be possible to collect work packs from school due to the lockdown requirements. Please could students and parents in the first instance try to access work on mobile phone devices and then complete work in exercise books provided to you as an alternative to photocopied packs: we have limited capacity to produce and send these packs to families and in the first instance, we need to prioritise those students who do not have any internet access.

Like many schools, we are looking for how we can best support children and families without connectivity and/or devices and we will keep you informed of next steps.
