An incident took place this morning involving one of our students. While walking to school, along the pathway next to the reservoir at the back of the school, a man in his 30s pushed a Year 7 student into the water. Thankfully the student is safe and made their way into school as quickly as possible. We immediately contacted the student's parents and reported the incident to the police.

This afternoon, through each Head of Year, messages have been given to all students about how best to remain safe walking to and from school.

This incident took place in an area that is particularly vulnerable. Therefore, if your child walks home that way, remind them to always walk with friends and stay away from the pathway that is next to the reservoir.
